Director To Give Talk

New Exhibit To Open At Marshall

Francoise Bonnell, director of the U.S. Army Women's Museum at Fort Lee, will talk about "A Debt to Democracy and a Date with Destiny: The Women's Army Corps and Its Legacy" beginning at 5:30 pm on Wednesday, Jan. 20, in the Pogue Auditorium at the Marshall Foundation.

This event is a part of the "All Who Want to Serve" sequence of the Marshall Legacy Series and is being presented in partnership with the U.S. Army Women's Museum.

Guests can see the exhibition, "For My Country, For Myself," that opens that evening.

Gen. George C. Marshall had a daunting problem to solve at the start of World War II: staffing the Army for a global war. As Marshall grew the Army to 8,000,000 in uniform by war's end in 1945, he encouraged all able-bodied

men and women to serve. Women, in particular, found Marshall's constant support during WWII. Starting with the formation of the Women's Army Auxiliary Corps in 1941 by Congressional act, he made this unit a full member of

the Army in 1943 as the Women's Army Corps. Women served in support roles in the Navy as WAVEs and in the (Army) Air Corps as WASPs. About 1.2 million women served in all services during WWII.

The George C. Marshall Legacy Series interprets Marshall's legacy through a multi-year series of exhibitions, speakers and programs centered on key themes or episodes from his career.
